Pinwheel Gardens -

Be a Pinwheel Gardener and Help Plant Hope

Bright blue pinwheels are a symbol of child abuse prevention awareness across the nation. Ralston House will be going to organizations in Jefferson, Adams and Broomfield Counties asking them to plant gardens of pinwheels in April to support the children in the community who have suffered abuse and to support efforts to keep children safe from abuse. Each garden demonstrates to child victims and their families that the community supports them. It says to children, "the abuse is not your fault. We are on your side, we believe you, and want to help you heal." Ralston House is Planting Hope with its gardens. In 2019, Ralston House will again be planting hope with its gardens. Their goal is to raise \$60,000 for Ralston House services from gardens and donations for individual pinwheels.

- **Volunteers:** for the egg hunt, registration, set-up/take down and more.

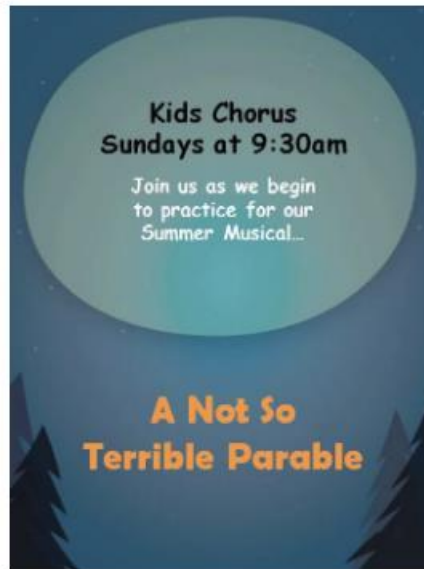

March is Eye Safety Month.

The computer age has brought us many conveniences, however with so many people using so many computers so much of the time, complaints of eye strain and discomfort have become common.



To help alleviate eye problems make sure to get a regular eye exam by an ophthalmologist. Other things you can do are:

- When you're in front of a computer screen, make sure you sit approximately 20 inches from the computer monitor with the top of the screen at or below eye level.
- Try to select an adjustable task or computer chair that allows height, angle and lumbar adjustments.
- Take periodic rest breaks and try to blink often to keep your eyes from drying out.
