### Randy Bevis - Honduras & Haiti

#### Roatan, Honduras Project

I just returned from a two week trip to the Island of Roatan Honduras where a team of 8 worked to get a 10 tank system to grow tilapia set up.

The project will produce food, both fish and vegetables to the children's home and also sell produce to the local community.

It will also provide training for the young people and others in the community.

While there we crossed over to the mainland and met another faith based project that has a red tilapia hatchery and Randy will be going back to help provide more training for the staff there as they have recently set up tilapia egg jars but didn't really know how to use them properly.

#### Haiti Project Update

Jeff our Haitian extension worker has been busy recruiting first time fish farmers from the community and helping them to dig pond. Approximately 10 ponds have been dug in the last few months and are being stocked by our new breeding pond at the university.

Randy and Kevin will be traveling there in early April to help Jeff train these new farmers.

#### Prayer Request:

Please Pray for Central African Republic. While there 14 rebel groups signed a peace agreement but this agreement has since failed and more Fulani refugees have been crossing over into Cameroon in the past two weeks.
