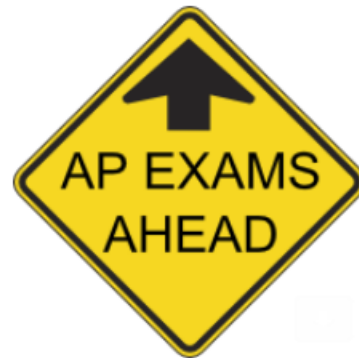

## Water Safety

It only takes a moment. A child or weak swimmer can drown in the time it takes to reply to a text, check a fishing line or apply sunscreen. Death and injury from drownings happen every day in home pools and hot tubs, at the beach or in oceans, lakes, rivers and streams, bathtubs, and even buckets. Here are some tips to help prevent drowning...



- Provide close and constant attention to children you are supervising in or near water.
- Learn swimming and water safety survival skills
- Always swim in a life-guarded area.
- Children, inexperienced swimmers, and all boaters should wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved life jacket.

In April we took our farewell tour to two of the SDRF centers. First, we spent some good time with Sao, the manager of CHAC (Center for HIV/AIDS Affected Communities). She rarely gets to the big city, so we all did an outing to the mall to watch the movie "A Dog's Way Home" together (in Thai!). What a tear jerker since we all LOVE dogs! It was a special time to just be together for fun instead of work. Please pray for Sao as she continues to supervise the center in south eastern Thailand alone next year. Please pray for her continued health too.

Then we drove the 24 hours north to our main office in Udon Thani. We had meetings with the president of our foundation, Nujon Singpila, and our co-worker, Jim Gustafson. We outlined the coming year, since Larry will continue to do IT work for the SDRF from the States while we are on home leave. Larry will also return to Thailand in July to help host two American church teams who are coming. One team is coming for a vision trip to see how they can continue to help the SDRF in the future. Another team will be putting a roof on the CHAC office building.

- May 7 to June 3 – We will be in Grand Rapids, Michigan and Buffalo, New York visiting family and supporters.
- June and July - We aren't certain of the exact timing yet, but we now plan to travel to Germany for Larry to have disc replacement surgery in his neck.
- Mid July. – Pam will return to our home in Fort Collins, Colorado. Larry will travel back to Thailand to host 2 church teams.
- August 20ish Larry returns from Thailand to join Pam in Fort Collins.
- August to May 2020 We will be living in Fort Collins, CO. We will be visiting supporting churches and donors, resting, and figuring out America again. :)
