What follows verse 12 is a splattering of descriptors involving Peter's impression of *living good lives*.

Did loving people make the list of descriptors? Absolutely! (vs 17)

How about showing respect for people? You bet! (vs 17)

Anything written on displaying our faith? He does mention fearing God (vs 17)

Are there words about taking care of the poor? Not in this section.

Did he write about being a voice for those suffering injustice? Nope, although he does write about our response to our own suffering and injustice.

In fact, the two descriptors that receive the most ink in this section of teaching are: *submitting* and *suffering* -- and both involve details pertaining to our own submission and suffering.

Hmm!

So our response and reaction to our own suffering are descriptors of *live such good lives among....?*

Yes!

Submitting/suffering and living good lives -- tough mix.

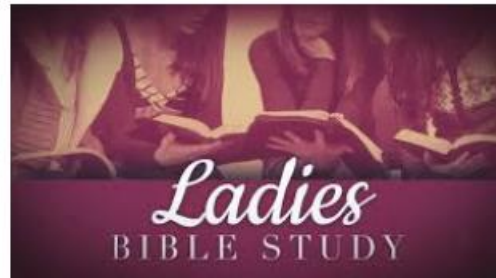


Authority of the Believer Bible Study

Training in Spain

During the last few months, we have been working with two church planting teams here in Spain and having a great time doing it. At the same time, the church we helped start here in Mejorada del Campo more than 20 years ago is still here and after some major ups and downs, a faithful core is working to regrow the church. We've also really enjoyed interacting with them.

The Continuing Mission of Church Planting in Spain

When Charlyn and I first arrived in Spain in 1989, the country was still getting used to democracy after the many years of the Franco dictatorship. There was a short period of opportunity for the gospel and during those early years we helped start a church in Arganda del Rey and another in Mejorada del Campo, both in the Madrid province. Today there continue to be opportunities, but cynicism and materialism continue to plague the Spanish mindset, making it difficult for many to freshly consider the good news of Jesus Christ. World Team has two teams on the East side of Madrid working to start new churches. One team is working among the people of Meco, near Alcalá de Henares. The other is working in the town of Velilla de San Antonio, near Mejorada where we previously started a church. We have had a great time working with these two church planting teams. Now they have worked hard on a strategy for ministry as well as a church planting plan for the the next year. In addition, we have worked with them on effective teamwork and culture learning. Again, thank you for your part in this ministry and your prayers.
